Taxes

The news this year is that the Township of Muskoka Lakes will have the lowest tax rate compared to other Muskoka municipalities. Residents here will see their rates increase by \$6.04 per \$100,000.00 of assessment. The township has approximately 14,000 properties on the tax assessment roll, 7,200 properties have an assessment of \$250,000.00 or less.

The District of Muskoka receives the majority of your tax dollar, about 49%, Education 37% and the Township of Muskoka Lakes 14%.

Bala Official Plan Review

It has come to the attention of the association that the Draft Township of Muskoka Lakes official plan proposes the establishment of an INDUSTRIAL zone along both sides of HWY 169 just north of Bala. The critical element here is that Industrial is not the same as commercial. This could permit chemical processing, industrial waste, equipment and machinery manufacturers to name a few.

We have issued a letter to council in serious objection to this proposal and will monitor the situation as required.
